The sound of church bells is a familiar one to most people in this country, and one that many couples wish to hear when they get married. In many churches those bells, and the frames which support them, are several centuries old. From time to time bell installations need overhauling, to ensure that the bells will continue to ring out now and for future generations. The Bell Restoration Fund of the Leicester Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers is a registered charity dedicated to maintaining and improving the quality of peals of bells across the Diocese of Leicester, which stretches across the historic county of Leicestershire.



Major work on church bells and their fittings, although required infrequently, can be expensive, and most parishes have many other calls on their finances. Without grant assistance many churches would struggle to keep their bells ringing, and a valuable part of this country's heritage would be lost.

Established in 1946, the Bell Restoration Fund has provided grants totalling almost £100,000 to over 120 churches across the diocese to help to keep bells in ringing order or provide additional bells to augment peals.
